Käesolev kogumik on järg 2015. aastal ilmunud „Eesti jazz noodis“ raamatule, mis tookord tähistas 90 aasta möödumist Eesti esimesest jazzkontserdist. Kogumik on mõeldud nii muusikule, muusikaõppurile kui ka asjaarmastajale, et tutvustada ja soosida kodumaise muusika mängimist ning harjutamist. Kaante vahelt leiab 68 kaasaegse Eesti jazzmuusiku loomingut.

Noodid on esitatud lihtsas *lead sheet* formaadis, mis jätab mängijale interpretatsiooni-, stiili- ja vormivabaduse. Kuna enamik noodistatud lugudest on ka salvestatud, siis on soovi korral võimalik õpitava looga salvestuse abil tutvuda. Lood on jagatud kolme raskusastmesse, mida tähistavad kriipsud noodilehe nurgal.

This collection is a sequel to Estonian Jazz Real Book published in 2015, which at the time marked the 90th anniversary of Estonia's first jazz concert. The collection is intended for musicians, music students and enthusiasts alike to introduce and popularize jazz music composed by Estonian musicians. In this publication you will find the works of 68 contemporary Estonian jazz musicians.

The scores are presented in a lead sheet format, which leaves room for own interpretation. Most of the published music is also available on recordings. The tunes are divided into three levels of difficulty, indicated by dashes in the corner of the sheet music.
