




Population changes per 1,000 population




Net migration



Population change








Population by ethnicity, 1 January 2007, %









Employed persons by economic activity, 2007, %



Gross domestic product per capita at current prices, euros










Value added by economic activity at current prices, 2007, %

Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania with capital cities
















Output of the agricultural 'industry'






